## ***ACI CONCRETE FIELD TECHNICIAN PROGRAM – GRADE 1***

### **CEMENT & CONCRETE PRODUCTS INDUSTRY OF HAWAII (CCPI)**

The ACI Certification Program for Concrete Field Testing Technician – Grade 1 is for the purpose of certifying concrete technicians who have demonstrated the knowledge and ability to properly perform the seven (7) basic field ASTM tests on freshly mixed concrete.

Classroom training on concrete mix designs and related ASTM standards. Participants will be instructed and view a video showing the proper procedures in performing these tests. Participants will be given the opportunity to practice the performance tests on freshly mixed concrete at the ready-mix plant. Participation in these opportunities is not mandatory to take the test.

Participant will be given both the ACI written and performance examinations. Those who pass both exams will be certified by ACI as an ACI Concrete Field Testing Technician Grade 1.

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**PAYMENT DEADLINE:** Registration form and payment must be received prior to attending the classroom review. See below for more information.

**CANCELLATIONS** must be made 7 days prior to the review session or 14 days prior to the exam date if there is no review session scheduled, to receive a complete refund. Late cancellations are subject to loss of registration fee. Substitutions may be made upon request and approval.

**POSTPONEMENTS** must be made 7 days prior to the review session or 14 days prior to the exam date if there is no review session scheduled. Postponements are allowed one time for next session at no additional cost. Any postponements made after the cutoff date will incur a fee of \$100 per occurrence.

**DISABILITY NOTICE:** If you have a disability and need assistance to participate in the training and/or to take the examination, please contact us at least two weeks prior to the scheduled date for the course.

**PLEASE BRING:** A calculator, paper, and pencil. As you will be handling concrete during the practice session and performance exams, the following shall be considered the minimum safety equipment required: Hard hat, high visibility clothing or vest, safety boots (steel or composite toe), safety glasses and hearing protection devices if needed. If you are missing any part of the minimum safety equipment you cannot enter or will be asked to leave the testing facility.
