***ACI CONCRETE FIELD TECHNICIAN PROGRAM – GRADE 1***

**CEMENT & CONCRETE PRODUCTS INDUSTRY OF HAWAII (CCPI)**

The ACI Certification Program for Concrete Field Testing Technician – Grade 1 certifies concrete technicians who have demonstrated the knowledge and ability to properly perform the seven (7) basic field ASTM tests on freshly mixed concrete. The schedule and registration form are below.

CCPI provides a review on basic concrete information and related ASTM standards via Zoom. Participants will be instructed and watch a video showing the proper procedures in performing these tests. Participants may schedule the opportunity to practice the performance tests on freshly mixed concrete by contacting the locations at the bottom of the registration form. Participation in these opportunities is not mandatory to take the certification exams.

Participant will be given both the ACI written and performance examinations. Those who pass both exams will be certified by ACI as an ACI Concrete Field Testing Technician Grade 1. Certification is valid for 5 years from the initial date of the exam.

**PAYMENT DEADLINE:** Registration form and payment must be received prior to attending the classroom review. See below for more information.

**CANCELLATIONS and SUBSTITUTIONS** must be made 14 days prior to the exam date to receive a complete refund. Late cancellations or substitutions are subject to loss of registration fee. Substitutions may be made upon request and approval.

**POSTPONEMENTS** must be made 14 days prior to the exam date. Postponements are allowed one time for next session at no additional cost. Any postponements or rescheduling made after the cutoff date will incur a fee of \$100 per occurrence.

**DISABILITY NOTICE:** If you have a disability and need assistance to participate in the training and/or to take the examination, please contact ACI at least two weeks prior to the scheduled date for the course.

**PLEASE BRING:** A calculator, paper, and pencil. During the practice session and written and performance exams, the following shall be considered the minimum safety equipment required: Hard hat, high visibility clothing or vest, safety boots (steel or composite toe), sleeved shirt, long pants, safety glasses and hearing protection devices if needed. If you are missing any part of the minimum safety equipment you cannot enter or will be asked to leave the testing facility without taking the exam.
